

Ian Currie

Ian Currie is a Consultant Surgeon in Transplantation and General Surgery. He performs liver, kidney and pancreas transplantation in Edinburgh, and is the Clinical Lead for the Abdominal Organ Retrieval Service in Scotland. In 2019, Mr Currie was appointed to the post of UK Clinical Lead for Organ Retrieval with NHS Blood and Transplant. In these latter roles, Ian supports and directs the programs of organ retrieval in Scotland and the UK.

Mr Currie has a clinically-focused research portfolio centered on transplantation. He has developed collaborations with the Department of Performance Psychology at the University of Edinburgh. These studies are centered on the human factors involved in complex teams providing organ retrieval with novel technologies. He is also building collaborations with the Department of Mathematics at Edinburgh so as to develop detailed modelling of the UK retrieval service, underpinning sustainability for the future. In parallel, Mr Currie is developing techniques to assess functional capacity of liver grafts after transplant so as to support research in graft optimisation.
