John Forsythe is Professor and Consultant Transplant Surgeon at the Edinburgh Royal Infirmary, Edinburgh, UK, a position he has held since 1995. Prior to this, he was a Consultant Surgeon with special interest in transplantation at the Royal Victoria Infirmary, Newcastle upon Tyne. Professor Forsythe is the Medical Director, Organ Donation and Transplantation, NHS Blood and Transplant. He has held many administrative roles including Lead Clinician for Organ Donation and Transplantation in Scotland and was Chair of the Advisory Committee for the Safety of Blood, Tissues and Organs (SaBTO) for many years. A prolific speaker, he has presented at numerous national and international meetings and chaired many sessions. His career has been marked by a number of awards and distinctions, including Moynihan Prize and Medal (Association of Surgeons of Great Britain and Ireland, 1989), Honeyman Gillespie Lecture (1998) and Rutherford Morison Lecture 2010. He is a Past President of BTS and Past President of European Society for Organ Transplantation
