Davide Ghinolfi was born in Italy in 1975. He attended the School of Medicine and Residency in General Surgery at the University of Genoa (Italy), where he got his PhD in Management of Organ Transplantation. He spent one year at the University of Massachusetts (2005) as research fellow and two years at the Mount Sinai Hospital in New York City (NY, USA) as a hepatobiliary and multiorgan transplant fellow (2007-2009). Since 2009 he is an attending surgeon at the division of Hepatobiliary Surgery and Liver Transplantation at the University of Pisa Medical School Hospital, the largest liver transplant program in Italy. His research interests are focused on the use of marginal grafts in liver transplantation (in particular older donors and DCD liver grafts) and on ex-situ normothermic perfusion. He is an expert in quality assessment and improvement programs in healthcare.
